**Dr. Christopher Emdin** is an Associate Professor in the Department of Mathematics, Science and Technology at Columbia University, where he also serves as Director of the Science Education Program and Associate Director of the Institute for Urban and Minority Education. He is an alumni fellow at the Hutchins Center at Harvard and has served as STEAM Ambassador for the U.S. Department of State and Minorities in Energy Ambassador for the U.S. Department of Energy. Dr. Emdin is a social critic, public intellectual and science advocate whose commentary on issues of race, culture, inequality and education have appeared in dozens of influential publications. A much sought-after speaker, he is the creator of the #HipHopEd movement. Dr. Emdin is the author of *Urban Science Education for the Hip-hop Generation* and *The NYT* bestseller *For White Folks Who Teach In the Hood and the Rest of Ya'll Too*.



**Dr. John Almarode** has presented nationally and internationally on the science of learning and has worked with hundreds of school districts and thousands of teachers. Dr. Almarode is an Associate Professor at James Madison University and Director of the Content Teaching Academy. His research interests include the science of learning and the design of classroom environments that promote student engagement. The work of John and his colleagues has been presented to the U.S. Congress, the U.S. Department of Education and the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy. He has authored or co-authored nine books including *Captivate, Activate and Invigorate the Student Brain in Science and Math*, *From Snorkelers to Scuba Divers* and *Teaching Mathematics in the Visible Learning Classroom*.



**Dr. Ruby Payne** is the founder of aha! Process and an author, speaker, publisher and career educator. Recognized internationally for *A Framework for Understanding Poverty*, her foundational book and workshop, Dr. Payne has helped students and adults of all economic backgrounds achieve academic, professional and personal success. As an expert on the mindsets of economic classes and overcoming the hurdles of poverty, she has trained hundreds of thousands of professionals – from educators to community, church and business leaders. Her other books include *Under-Resourced Learners: 8 Strategies to Boost Student Achievement* and the award-winning *Boys in Poverty: A Framework for Understanding Dropout*.

As a social philosopher, he has pioneered efforts to bring neuro-biology and brain research into homes, schools, corporations, and public policy. The Gurian Institute, which he co-founded, conducts research internationally, launches pilot programs, and trains professionals throughout North America.



**Baruti Kafele** is an award-winning principal, internationally-renowned education speaker and best-selling author. A highly-regarded urban public school educator in New Jersey, Principal Kafele distinguished himself in the classroom and as a school leader. As a middle and high school principal, he led the transformation of four different schools, including “The Mighty” Newark Tech, which went from a low-performing school to being recognized three times as one of America’s best high schools by *U.S. News and World Report*. Principal Kafele is one of the most sought-after speakers for transforming the attitudes of at-risk students. He is the author of a number of books including *Closing the AttitudeGap* and *The Teacher 50*.

Stemberg Endowed Chair in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Ablon is author of *The School Discipline Fix* and *Changeable: The Surprising Science Behind Helping Anyone Change* and co-author of *Treating Explosive Kids: The Collaborative Problem-Solving Approach*. Dr. Ablon received his doctorate in clinical psychology from the University of California at Berkeley and completed his training at Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Medical School. A dynamic and engaging speaker, Dr. Ablon was ranked #5 on the list of the world’s top rated keynote speakers in the academic arena. He trains parents, educators and clinicians, and helps organizations throughout the world implement the Collaborative Problem Solving approach.
